The work that has gone on with construction since September 2012 is finally going to feel the joy of the young people who can experience a solid Jesuit education opening them to a challenging future.


Thank you so very much for being part of this exciting moment! Please take a look at the photos enclosed here -- you can see how we are using your donation. Let us know your reactions.....
