OPENING RITES

Greeting:

1. Greeting by Priest: In the name of the Creator, the Redeemer, and the Sanctifier.

Response: Amen

2. Priest: The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you all.

Response: And also with you.

Penitential Rite:

3. Priest: Lord, have mercy - Christ have mercy - Lord, have mercy

Response: Lord, have mercy - Christ have mercy - Lord, have mercy

4. Priest: May almighty God have mercy on us, forgive us our sins, and bring us to everlasting life.

Response: Amen

5. Priest: Let us pray... (opening prayer)

Response: Amen

LITURGY OF THE WORD

First and Second Readings:

6. At end, Reader says: The word of God.

Response: Thanks be to God.

Gospel Reading:

7. Priest (at beginning): The Lord be with you.

Response: And also with you.

8. Priest: A reading from the holy Gospel according to...

Response: Glory to you, O God

9. Priest (at end of reading): This is the Gospel of the Lord

Response: Praise to you, Jesus Christ

Prayers of the Faithful:

10. God hear our prayer.

Response: God hear us.

LITURGY OF THE EUCHARIST

Preparation of the Gifts

11. Priest: Blessed are you, Lord God of all creation, for through your goodness we have received the bread we offer you: fruit of the earth and work of human hands, it will become for us the bread of life.

Response: Blessed be God for ever.

12. Priest: Blessed are you, Lord God of all creation, for through your goodness we have received the wine we offer you: fruit of the vine and work of human hands, it will become our spiritual drink.

Response: Blessed be God for ever.

13. Priest: Pray, brothers and sisters that my sacrifice and yours may be acceptable to God.

Response: May God accept the sacrifice at your hands, for the praise and glory of God's name, for our good and the good of all God's holy church.

Eucharistic Prayer

14. Priest: The Lord be with you.

Response: And also with you.

15. Priest: Lift up your hearts.

Response: We have lifted them up to God.

Priest: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God

Response: It is right to give God thanks and praise.

(We sing the responses Holy, Holy; Memorial Acclamation; Great Amen.)

Lord's Prayer/Our Father (and Mother)

Response: Amen.

16. Priest: Deliver us Lord from every evil... as we await the blessed hope and the coming of our Savior, Jesus Christ.

Response: For the kingdom, the power and the Glory are yours, now and forever. Amen.

The priest may say words of the Sign of Peace since they are usually in this part of the Mass. If so, respond:

17. Priest: Who lives and reign for ever and ever

Response: Amen

18. Priest: The peace of the Lord be with you always

Response: And with your spirit.

19. Lamb of God – Say together with the priest:

Lamb of God, you take away the sins of the world, have mercy on us. Lamb of God, you take away the sins of the world, have mercy on us. Lamb of God, you take away the sins of the world, grant us peace.

20. Priest: Behold the Lamb of God, behold him who takes away the sins of the world. Blessed are those called to the supper of the lamb.

Response: Lord, I am not worthy to receive you, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed.

CLOSING RITES

21. Final Blessing – Priest: The Lord be with you.

Response: And also with you.

22. May almighty God bless you, the Creator, Redeemer and Sanctifier.

Response: Amen.

23. Go in peace, the Mass is ended.

Response: Thanks be to God.
